Diesel locomotive 2095.13 of the Austrian Federal Railways.

The class 2095 locomotives procured from 1958 onwards formed the backbone of the ÖBB on the diesel-powered narrow-gauge lines for decades. They were used for passenger and freight traffic, especially for rolling stock/roller wagon transport. The 2095s were used on the narrow-gauge lines of the Ybbstalbahn, the Bregenzeraldbahn, the Krimmlerbahn, the Waldviertelbahn and on the so-called "Krumpe" lines. The latter formed the now disused local railway from Ober-Grafendorf to Gresten.
